

APPLY FOR INFORMAL TRADING STALLS AND RETAIL MARKET SPACE

INTERESTED members of the public are invited to apply for vacant trading stalls, units, or kiosks and the management of storage available in various regions throughout the City before 28 May 2024 at 12pm.

In the Central Business District there are about 70 available sites while there are 17 sites available in the inner and outer west. There are 104 sites available in the south while the upper north has approximately 19 sites. There are seven available sites in the coastal areas and 86 vacant sites within retail markets.

Most of the available trading spaces have been newly built or revamped to improve informal trading facilities. This includes the multimillion-rand uMlazi V Business Hive.
